Directions to QMUL Mile End Campus

The QMUL Mile End Campus is midway between Stepney Green and Mile End tube stations and has two entrances East Gate and West Gate as indicated in the map below. The Campus Map is also enclosed where the venues of the meeting, accommodation and lunch are highlighted.

Joseph Priestley Building (meeting point on Monday 1st July)

- From Mile End tube station: turn left and walk along the Mile End Road. Pass under a yellow bridge, over the canal and take the first right into campus. It is the East Gate entrance to QMUL.
- From Stepney Green tube station: turn right and walk along the Mile End Road. You will pass a number of Queen Mary buildings on your left. After you pass the Law and ArtsOne buildings turn left. When you walk up Westfield Way, you will pass student accommodation buildings on the right, the Joseph Priestley Building is on your left.




The reception is on the ground floor. The entrance is located at the end of the building.
